



Dear Parents and Students,

Your child's summer reading list has been created based on his/her personal reading comprehension level! Students will choose books according to their individual lexile score.

Students entering 2nd grade will choose two books from the appropriate lexile list to read. For one book, a test will be taken in the Reading Room during the first nine weeks of school. For the other book, students will complete a book report using the form that is included.

When choosing books from the list, do not choose books on which you have already tested in the Reading Room. There may be books on the list that are picture books which are meant to be read aloud to younger children. Do not choose those for your reading. Second graders may - but do not have to - read chapter books.

You can find your child's lexile score in his or her report card envelope. If this lexile score is misplaced during the summer, the child must read the following books:
