

Homecoming 2018: A RED CARPET EVENT!

Schedule of Events:

- Thursday, October 18th: parade, pep rally, and bonfire
 - Events begin at 5:30 with the parade and the pep rally and bonfire following immediately after the parade.
- Friday, October 19th: football game with homecoming court presentation at halftime
- Saturday, October 20th: dance- 8-11 in the school gym

Dress Up Days: Remember all Dress Day Attire MUST BE APPROPRIATE and follow the school dress code.

- Monday, October 15th: Dress like an award winning celebrity
- Tuesday, October 16th: Pajama day
- Wednesday, October 17th: Dress as your Favorite Entertainer
- Thursday, October 18th: Hollywood Movie- high school dress like your class' movie theme (elementary/middle school- dress like movie character or actor/actress or paparazzi)

Homecoming Parade:

- 9th-12th grade classes will compete in a float decorating competition. Floats will be fully assembled the afternoon of Thursday, October 18th. Students will attend regular classes that morning, but will have float decorating time in the afternoon. Each class sponsor is responsible for his/her class float. Sponsors will have meetings with the class to discuss the float.
- Students must have a signed permission slip in order to ride on the float.
- Candy may not be thrown. Things like cups, small footballs, etc. are allowed.
- 9th-12th grade students will be allowed to bring their cell phones to school on Thursday, October, 18th. Students must turn phones in to their class sponsor who will hold phone until float decorating after lunch. Students will be able to use them in the afternoon.

Bonfire:

- Seniors are responsible for lighting the bonfire. Each senior is responsible to provide a tiki torch. Summer is a great time to find them (just about any store has them).

Dance Dress Code:

- Girls' Dress Code for Dances:
 - **All dresses must be approved by Monday, October 15th. HBCS students and outside guests must do ONE of the following:**
 - **1. Send in a picture of the student wearing the dress (back and front view) to the Ms. B. White or Mrs. T. White - email pictures to either bwhite@hbcnsi.org or twhite@hbcnsi.org**
 - **2. Students must bring the dress to school to try on after school at a time previously arranged with the event sponsor.**
 - General Dress Guidelines (however dress must be approved):
 - A bra or 'built-in' bra must be worn; neckline cannot reveal cleavage.
 - Dresses must be modest and have modest hemlines
- Boys' Dress Code for Dances:
 - Slacks and button down or collared shirt.
 - No jeans or tennis shoes allowed.

Dance Tickets:

- Tickets for the dance will be sold in the school office during community time. Dates for ticket sales will be determined once school starts.
- **ALL guests must be in high school OR under 20 years of age *and* no more than one year out of high school.**
- Each guest attending from another school must complete a guest form. These forms will be available in Ms. Brittney White's classroom in September. Guest forms will be due on October 15th. Remember guests must comply with the dress code requirements.

A Note About Toilet Papering:

HBCS does not condone any toilet papering. Administration also reminds you that toilet papering is illegal and could result in criminal charges.
