We hope you and your families all had a wonderful Thanksgiving. As many of you have probably heard, Governor Edwards announced Louisiana is in a modified version of phase two of our COVID response. Thankfully, this does not change anything for us as a school. We would request that you speak with your students and remind them about the importance of hand washing, social distancing, and masks (grades 3rd through 12th) as we return to school.

It is also very important as we return to school Monday that your student not come to school if they have been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or is presumed positive and waiting for test results (ex. if they have been in close contact with someone who cannot taste and/or smell). Your student will need to complete a 14 day quarantine regardless of a negative COVID test if they are considered a close contact.

Your student should also not come to school if they have any COVID symptoms or are sick in any way.

If your student cannot come to school due to being sick or being quarantined, please contact administration.

Thank you for helping us to keep our students and faculty safe as we continue to navigate this school year.
