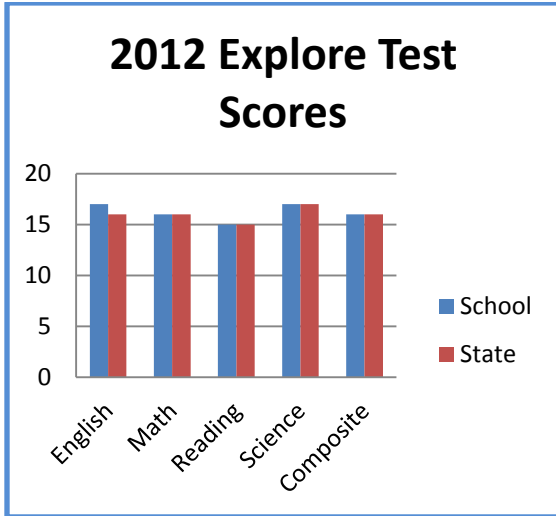
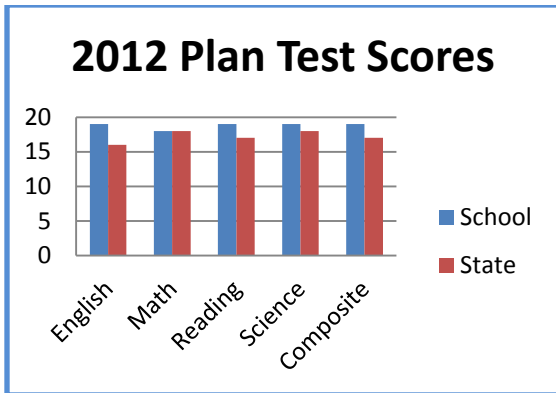


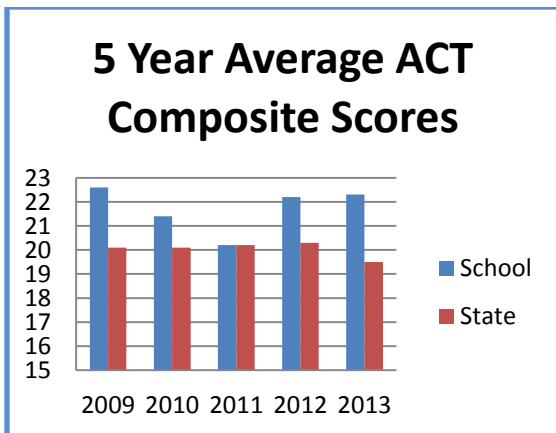
HIGH SCHOOL SCORE SUMMARY



The EXPLORE exam, developed by ACT, is administered to 9th graders each fall. The test measures academic development in English, mathematics, reading, and science reasoning and provides important information about the students' interests, needs, and plans. The information can be a vital resource in helping 9th grade students make appropriate plans for high school and the future.



This exam, also developed by ACT, is administered each fall to 10th graders; it includes tests in English, math, reading and science reasoning. This test helps students identify individual goals as well as learn more about themselves and the world of work.



The ACT is a national college admissions examination that consists of subject area tests in: English, mathematics, reading, and science. The ACT Plus Writing includes the four subject area tests plus a 30-minute Writing Test. ACT results are accepted by all four-year colleges and universities in the United States.
