The players will begin hitting at 9 AM. Once this has concluded, the field will be opened to anyone in attendance to see how far they can hit. This will be available for \$1 per swing with no limits. A tee will also be available for the younger kids to get out and play on the field. Burgers, hot dogs, and additional concessions will be available for purchase. A fun jump will be provided for those that just want to play. Admission to this event will be free. Please come out and support our baseball team and wish them well on the upcoming season. How the Hit-a-Thon Works

Get Sponsors: Between now and March 23, 2019, each athlete is asked to talk to friends, family, neighbors who would like to support them and help raise money for HBCS Baseball.

Collect Pledges: The Supporter can sponsor an athlete in two ways:

1. **Lump sum pledge-** donate a designated amount in the name of a player
2. **Pledge per foot-** donations can be made to the athlete in the amount per foot the ball travels. Each athlete will get 10 swings and all hits will be measured. Pledge amount will be based on the players longest hit. Any ball that is hit over the fence will be counted as 400 feet. The minimum distance recorded will be 200 feet.
