

Homecoming 2017

Schedule of Events:

- Thursday, Sept. 14th: parade, pep rally, and bonfire
 - Events begin at 5:30 with the parade and the pep rally and bonfire following immediately after the parade.
- Friday, Sept. 15th: football game with homecoming court presentation at halftime
- Saturday, Sept. 16th: dance- 8-11 in the school gym

Dress Up Days:

- Wednesday, Sept. 13th - Home Run (sports day)
- Thursday, Sept. 14th- (Louisiana Day)
- Friday, Sept. 15th- Home Sweet Home (green and gold)
 - HBCS dress code applies to dress up days. No holes/ rips in jeans, shorts must meet 3in. above the knee rule.

Homecoming Parade:

- 9th-12th grade classes will compete in a float decorating competition. Floats will be fully assembled the afternoon of Thursday, Sept. 14th. Students will attend regular classes that morning, but will have float decorating time in the afternoon. Each class sponsor is responsible for his/her class float. Sponsors will have meetings with the class to discuss the float.
- Students must have a signed permission slip in order to ride on the float.
- Candy may not be thrown. Things like cups, small footballs, etc. are allowed.
- 9th-12th grade students will be allowed to bring their cell phones to school on Thursday, Sept. 14th. Students must turn phones in to their class sponsor who will hold phone until float decorating after lunch. Students will be able to use them in the afternoon.

Bonfire:

- Seniors are responsible for lighting the bonfire. Each senior is responsible to provide a tiki torch. Summer is a great time to find them (just about any store has them).

Dance Dress Code:

- Girls' Dress Code for Dances:
 - **All dresses must be approved before the dance. HBCS students and outside guests must do ONE of the following:**
 - **1. Send in a picture of the student wearing the dress (back and front view) to the event sponsor (homecoming sponsor will be Ms. B. White - email pictures to bwhite@hbcnsi.org)**

- **2. Students must bring the dress to school to try on after school at a time previously arranged with the event sponsor.**
- General Dress Guidelines (however dress must be approved):
 - A bra or 'built-in' bra must be worn; neckline cannot reveal cleavage.
 - Dresses must be modest and have modest hemlines
- Boys' Dress Code for Dances:
 - Slacks and button down or collared shirt.
 - No jeans or tennis shoes allowed.

Dance Tickets:

- Tickets for the dance will be sold in the school office during community time. Tickets will go on sale Monday, August 21st. Tickets will be \$15 each, but a special will be run August 21st - Sept. 1st where tickets will be 2 for \$25. The last day to purchase tickets will be Sept. 12th.
- **ALL guests must be in high school OR under 20 years of age *and* no more than one year out of high school.**
- Each guest attending from another school must complete a guest form. These forms will be available in Ms. Brittney White's classroom once school starts. Guest forms will be due on Sept. 12th. Remember guest must comply with the dress code requirements.

A Note to Senior Girls:

- Homecoming court will be voted on during the first full week of school. It would be a good idea for you to start thinking about what you might want to wear should you be chosen for court. The following will be required for court: Halftime requires a suit or a dress with a jacket. Hats are required. Picture for newspaper/program/yearbook requires dressy pants or an almost to the knee dress.
