Students entering 7th through 12th grades have the **OPTION** to complete set requirements on **ReadTheory.org**. If you (the student) already have a ReadTheory account using your school email address, then you will continue to use the same account and login. However, if you have not used ReadTheory yet, you will need to create an account using your HBCS issued email address.

What is Read Theory? Read Theory is a **FREE** powerful educational tool that offers online reading activities for all ages and ability levels. Its custom web application adapts to students' individual ability levels and presents them with thousands of skill building exercises that suit their needs.

There are numerous benefits of completing this optional assignment:

- Gauges and gears the quizzes to your reading comprehension abilities,
- Great practice and prep for ACT Testing, and
- Will be utilized throughout your English class for the entirety of the school year.

You need to add your ReadTheory account to the following class that pertains to the grade level you will be entering during the 2020-2021 school year:

- If you are entering 7th grade (Class of 2028), you are to use the following code to enter Mr. Badger's English Class: **9DSR3CT8**
- If you are entering 8th grade (Class of 2027), you are to use the following code to enter Mrs. Mitchell's English Class: **Y77327KF**
- If you are entering 9th grade (Class of 2026), you are to use the following code to enter Mrs. Boswell's English Class: **JNCVP5UC**
- If you are entering 10th grade (Class of 2025), you are to use the following code to enter Mrs. Dawbin's English Class: **AW4JQ5TH**
- If you are entering 11th grade (Class of 2024), you are to use the following code to enter Mrs. Boswell's English Class: **K8E9B42G**
- If you are entering 12th grade (Class of 2023), you are to use the following code to enter Mrs. Dawbin's English Class: **X79C2D9P**

If you complete the following requirements on ReadTheory, you will be compensated by your English teacher and administration:

- You have to achieve **700 KNOWLEDGE POINTS** (averages about 50 to 70 points a week, at 11 weeks of summer)
- The culmination of the KNOWLEDGE POINTS count from **Monday, May 23rd**, and needs to be completed by **Monday, August 15th**.
